### JEB DUNNUCK 94

#### 2022 Domaine Maby Lirac Maestro

Black raspberries, darker berries, salted meats, and sappy, floral notes all emerge from the 2022 Lirac Maestro, a beautifully textured, medium to full-bodied red based on 100% Mourvèdre. It's complex, has ample mid-palate depth, and ripe tannins.

### JEB DUNNUCK 93

#### 2023 Domaine Maby Lirac Casta Diva Blanc

The 2023 Lirac Casta Diva Blanc is slightly more exotic, with honeyed melon, toasted spices, and floral nuances to go with a medium-bodied richness and depth on the palate. It's balanced, has building richness, background oak, and a great finish.

### JEB DUNNUCK 92

#### 2023 Domaine Maby Tavel Libiamo

Geared for the dinner table, the 2023 Tavel Libiamo is half Grenache Noir and half Grenache Blanc that was vinified and aged in demi-muids. Savory strawberries, Provençal herbs, and some spicy notes define the aromatics, and it's medium bodied on the palate, textured, and concentrated for a rosé, with terrific overall balance.

### JEB DUNNUCK 91

#### 2022 Domaine Maby Lirac Nessun Dorma

A Syrah-dominated cuvée that includes 20% Grenache, the 2022 Lirac Nessun Dorma is deep ruby-hued and has a terrific nose of black raspberries, smoked meat, pepper, and spring flowers. This spicy, complex, medium to full-bodied Syrah has terrific balance, ripe and integrated tannins, and outstanding length. It's going to be worth following over the coming 8-10 years.

## **JEB DUNNUCK** **91**

### **2022 Domaine Maby Lirac Bel Canto**

All Grenache, the 2022 Lirac Bel Canto sports a translucent ruby hue to go with a beautiful array of wild strawberry and framboise fruits as well as some loamy soil, spice, and dried flower notes. It's medium-bodied and has a silky, elegant mouthfeel and nicely integrated tannins.

## **JEB DUNNUCK** **90**

### **2023 Domaine Maby Lirac La Fermade Blanc**

The classic cuvée from this estate, the 2023 Lirac La Fermade Blanc is based on 55% Grenache, 25% Clairette, and 10% each Picpoul and Ugni Blanc, raised all in stainless steel. Orange blossom, ripe melon, and pear notes all define the aromatics, and it's medium-bodied on the palate, with a nicely textured, balanced, concentrated style that will allow it to shine on the dinner table. I'd be thrilled to drink a bottle.

## **JEB DUNNUCK** **90**

### **2023 Domaine Maby Tavel La Forcadiere**

The classic Tavel from this estate, the 2023 Tavel La Forcadiere is based on 30% Grenache Noir, 25% Cinsault, and 15% Grenache Blanc, with the rest a mix of varieties. Its deep ruby (classic Tavel) color is followed by a textbook nose of wild strawberry and cherry fruits as well as some Provençal herb and spicy notes. It has a medium-bodied, round, textured style on the palate.

### **2023 Domaine Maby Tavel Prima Donna**

A smaller production release, the 2023 Tavel Prima Donna comes all from pebbly soils and is based on 50% each Grenache Noir and Cinsault. Textbook savory strawberry, framboise, and mineral, subtly floral notes all give way to a medium-bodied Tavel that's balanced, has integrate acidity, and outstanding length.

### **2022 Domaine Maby Lirac La Fermade**

The 2022 Lirac La Fermade is mostly Mourvèdre but includes 30% Grenache and 20% Syrah. Black cherries, darker berries, peppery herbs, and some underbrush notes all define the aromatics, and it's medium-bodied, with some savory tannins and a good finish.

## Les rosés de terroir existent-ils vraiment ?

Au-delà des “rosés piscine” qui déferlent sur les tables estivales, certains domaines qui revendiquent leur production comme des “rosés de terroir” se sont regroupés au sein d’une association internationale. Que valent ces vins ? Une dégustation de Karine Valentin

Un rosé est-il nécessairement un vin superficiel, à boire l’été au bord de la piscine ? Certains grands domaines produisent des rosés qui reflètent le terroir sur lequel ils sont nés et capables de vieillir des décennies. Et pour lutter contre l’image du “rosé piscine”, des vigneron·nes de Tavel appellent à l’union. En 2021, ils fédèrent d’autres vigneron·nes de France autour d’un projet commun de mise en valeur de la couleur et, ensemble, ils créent l’Association internationale des Rosés de Terroirs, présidée aujourd’hui par Philippe Guigal, dans le but de promouvoir le rosé qui, à l’égal des blancs ou des rouges, peut se garder plusieurs années.

Les galets roulés apportent au vin cette élégante tenue, valorisant une aromatique puissante sur un fruit franc, groseille, fraise, cerise. On attend encore *a minima* deux ans.
